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#### OBE

Outcome-based education (OBE) is an education reform model largely aimed at primary and secondary education ("K-12" in the United States and Australia) which is intended to objectively measure student performance.

#### OBE

Outcome-based education (OBE) is a recurring education reform model. It is a *student-centred learning philosophy* that focuses on empirically measuring student performance, which are called *outcomes*. OBE contrasts with traditional education, which primarily focuses on the resources that are available to the student, which are called *inputs*.

#### Historical Development of OBE

#### 1. Mastery Learning

Acquisition of cognitive, affective and psychomotor skills under appropriate conditions

#### 2. Competence-based education

Acquisition of a group of skills that bring about competence in a specific field, which is assessed against pres-set benchmarks defined by industry

#### 3. Outcomes-based education

Demonstration of acquired generic skills in different contexts, that are assessed against pre-set criteria agreed upon by all stakeholders

#### OBE on Learning

## Outcomes Based Education focuses on student learning by:

- Using learning outcome statements to make explicit what the student is expected to be able to know, understand or do;
- Providing learning activities which will help the student to reach these outcomes;
- Assessing the extent to which the student meets these outcomes through the use of explicit assessment criteria

- All Educators have to re-curriculate using:
  - Unit standards
  - Learning outcomes
- Identify and incorporate CCFO's

#### Critical Cross-field Outcomes

- SAQA defines CCFOs as "those generic outcomes that inform all teaching and learning"
- CCFOs 'are those outcomes deemed critical for the development of the capacity for life-long learning'.

Identify and solve problems in which responses demonstrate that responsible decisions using critical and creative thinking have been made.

- Student-centred approaches to learning-

 Work effectively with others as a member of a team, group, organisation, community

- Group assignments -

 Organise and manage oneself and one's activities responsibly and effectively

- Calendars and time on task -

Collect, analyse, organise and critically evaluate information

- Active contribution, using social networking -

 Communicate effectively using visual, mathematical and/or language skills in the modes of oral and/or written presentation

- Using various application to respond in a (multi)media rich response -

 Use science and technology effectively and critically, showing responsibility towards the environment and health of others

- Using ICT's -


 Demonstrate an understanding of the world as a set of related systems by recognising that problem-solving contexts do not exist in isolation


## HE Teaching and Learning

- Respect diverse talents and ways of learning








# ...LMS Integration into facebook – displaying Grades...




